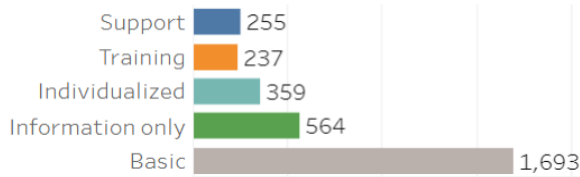

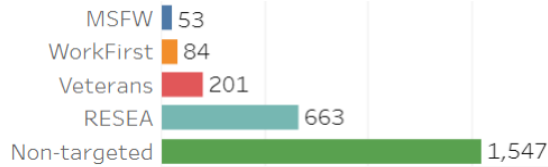


### Staff assisted seekers served by service type\*



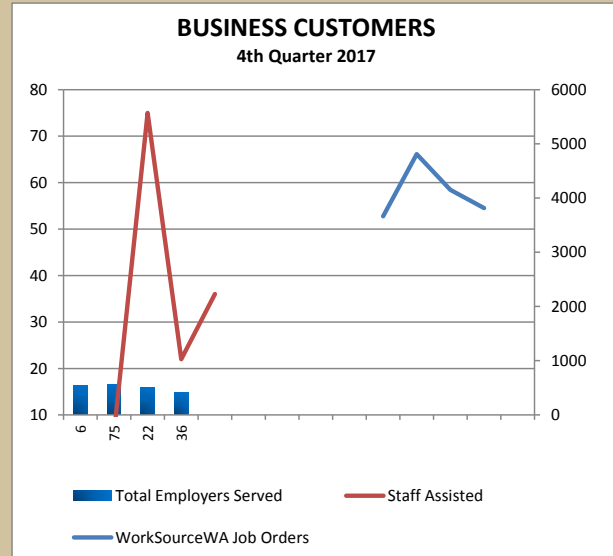
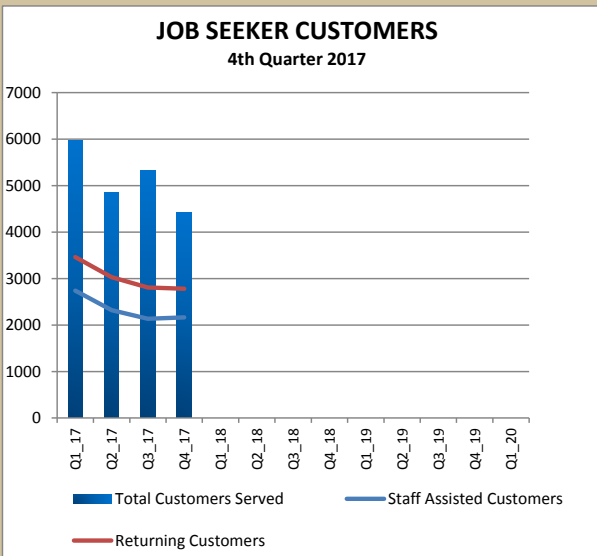
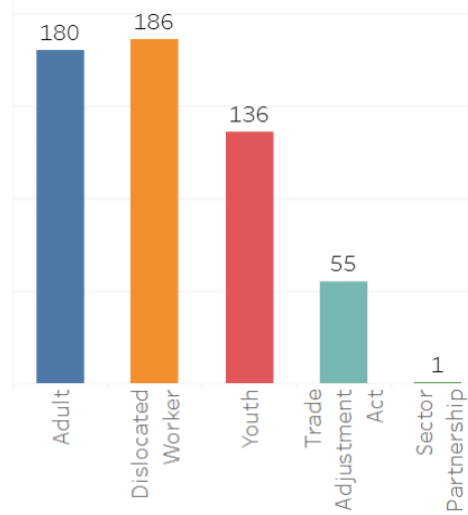

### Staff assisted seekers by cohort

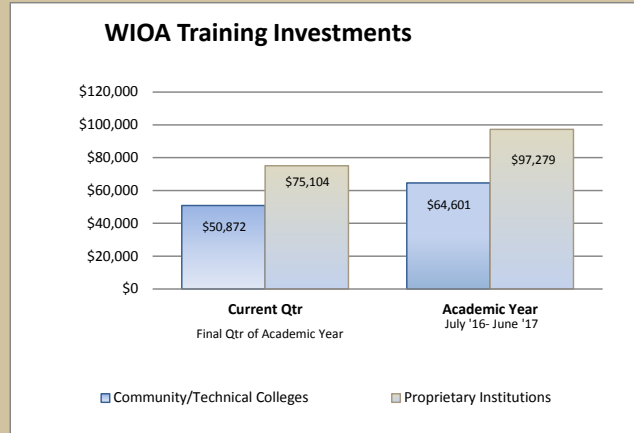
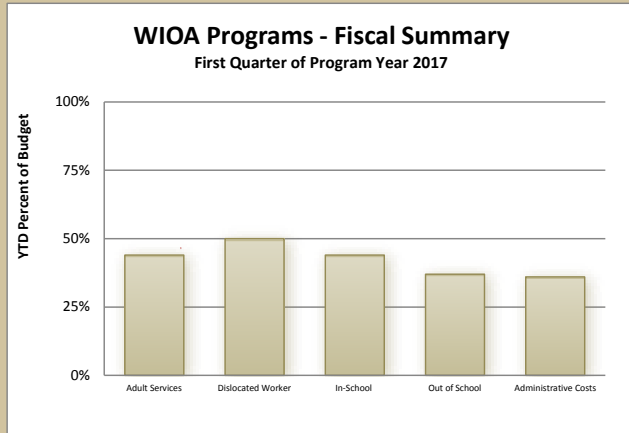


### Seekers served by program enrollment

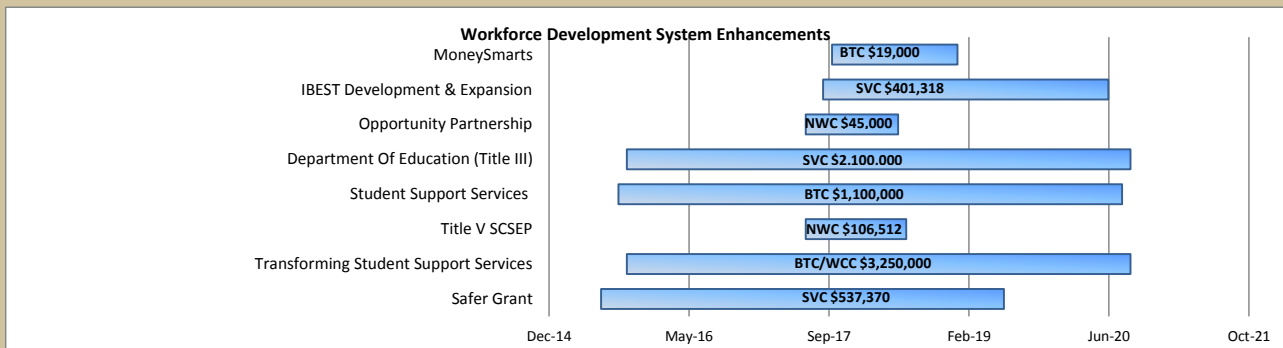
Staff-assisted seeker counts by service location, regardless of enrollment location



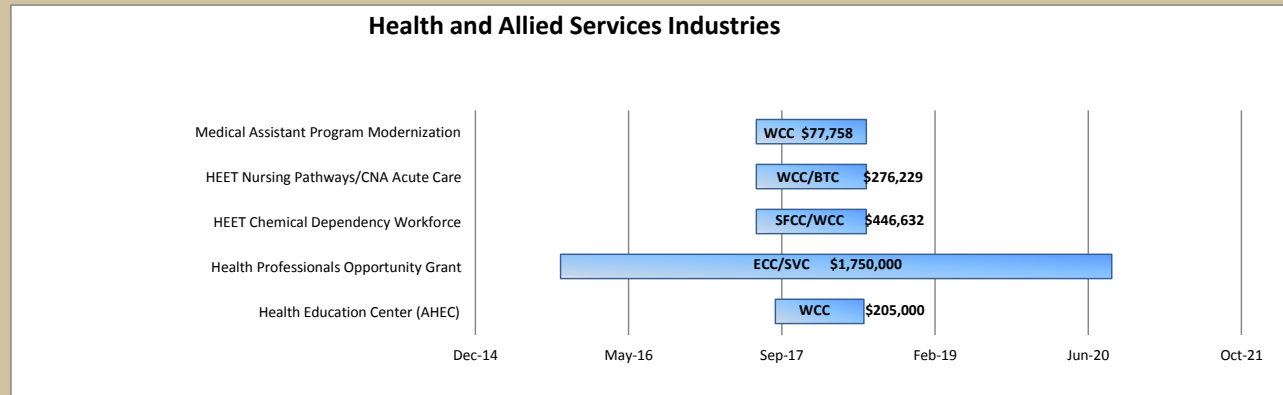

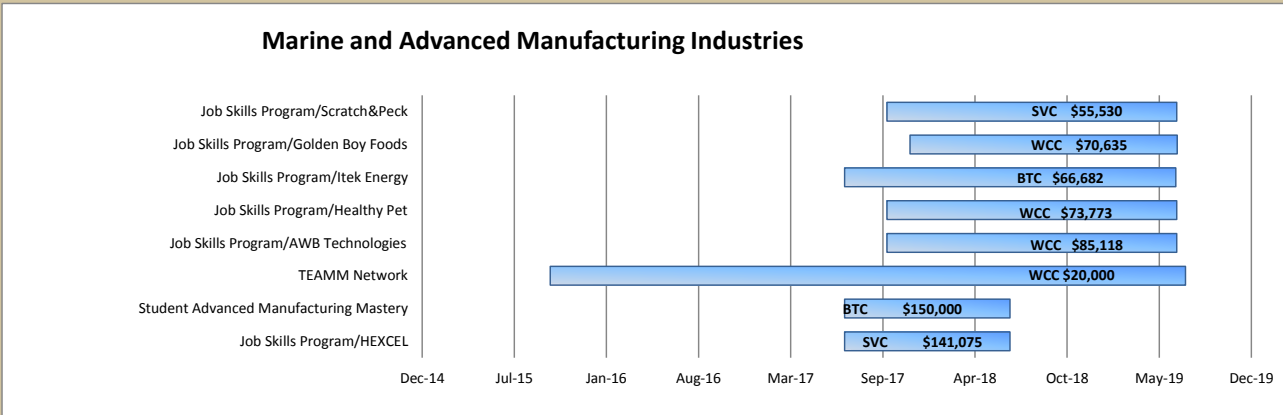

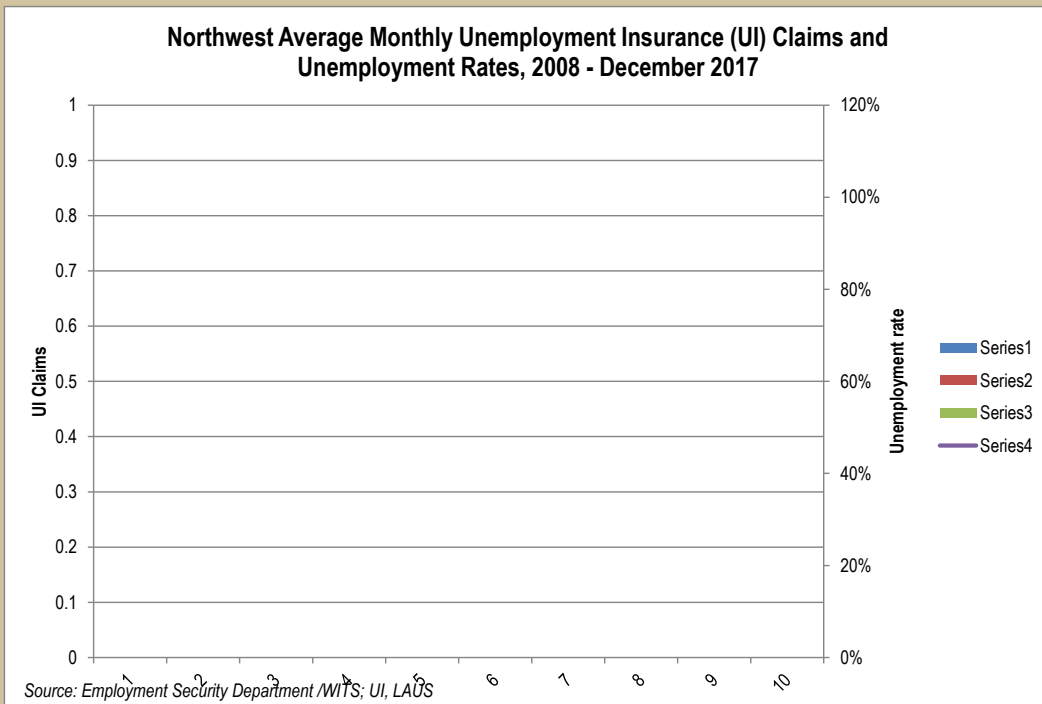

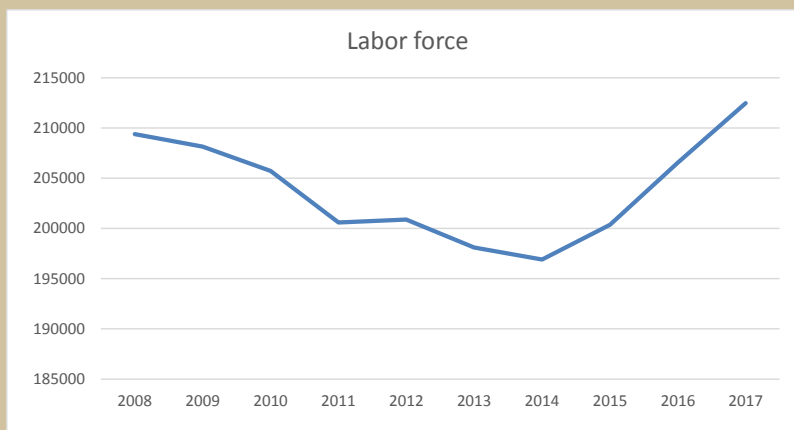


In 2017, the unemployment rate has been coming down at a slightly higher rate than previously observed.

In December 2017, the not seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for WDA 3 was 5.2% Compare to 6.0% in December 2016.

In December 2017, Skagit had the highest unemployment rate (5.8%) followed by Island (5.5%). Whatcom (5.0%) and San Juan (4.5%)

The resident civilian labor force was 214,669 (est.) in December 2017, an annual increase of nearly 5,000 workers (2.4%).
