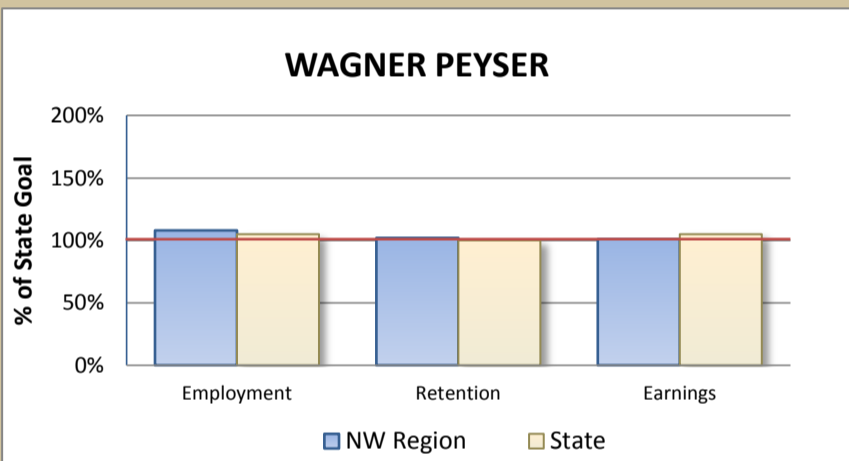

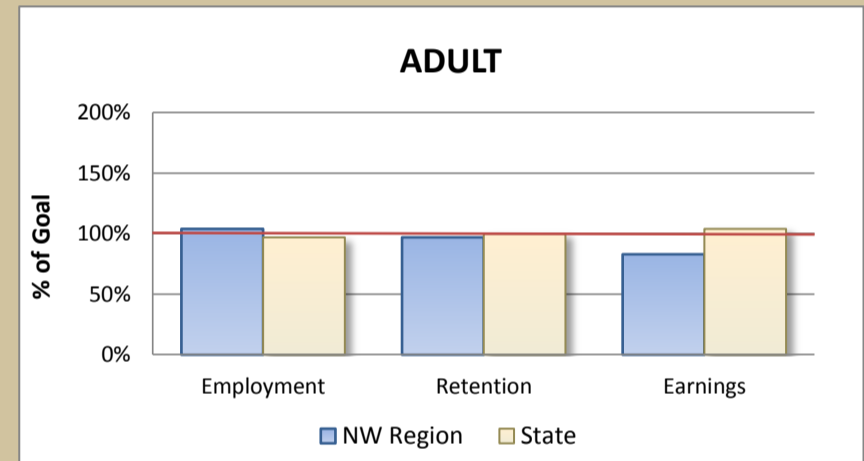

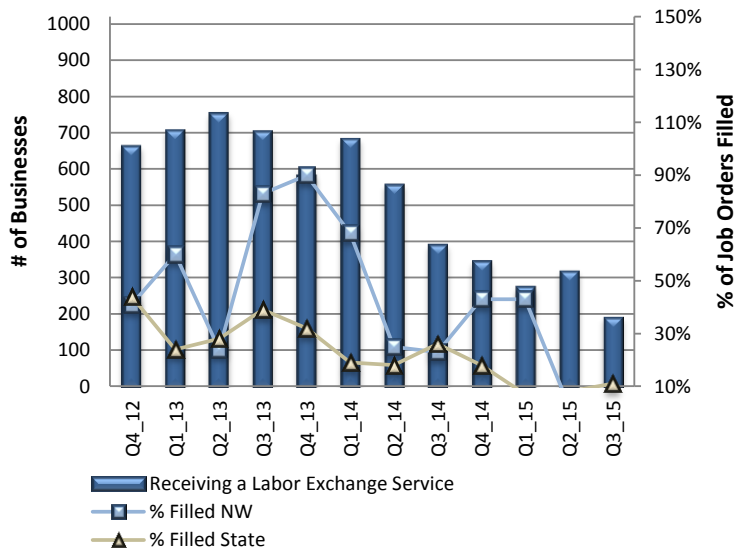

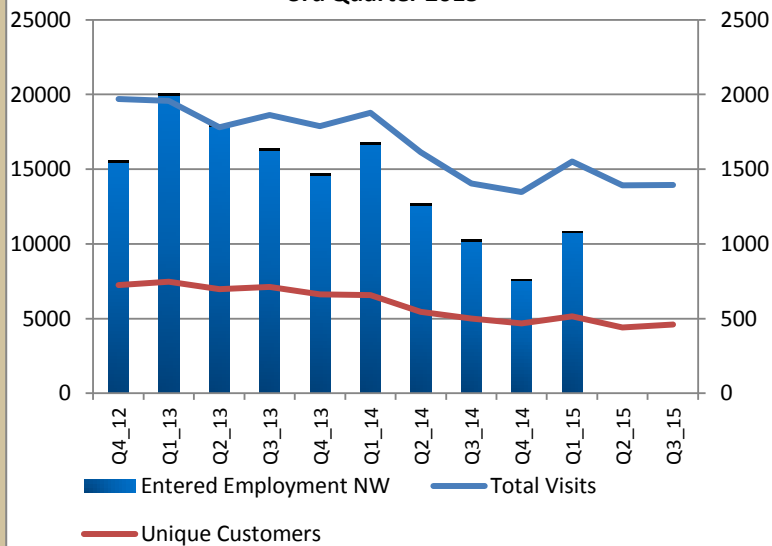
BUSINESS CUSTOMERS 3rd Quarter 2015



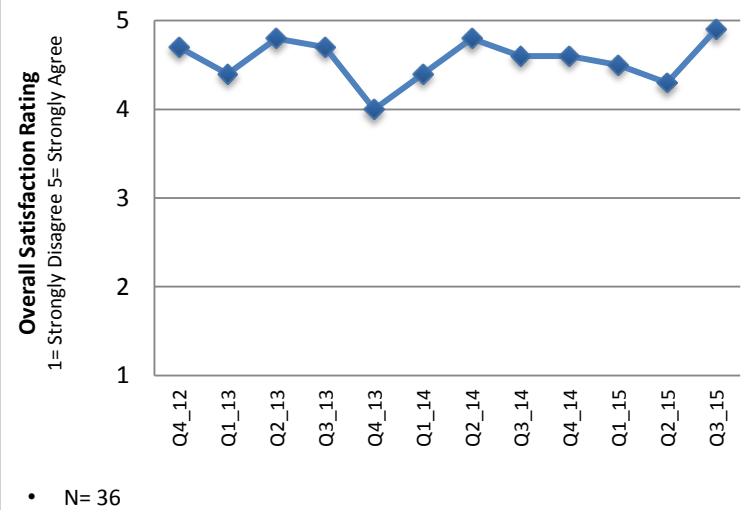
BUSINESS SATISFACTION 3rd Quarter 2015

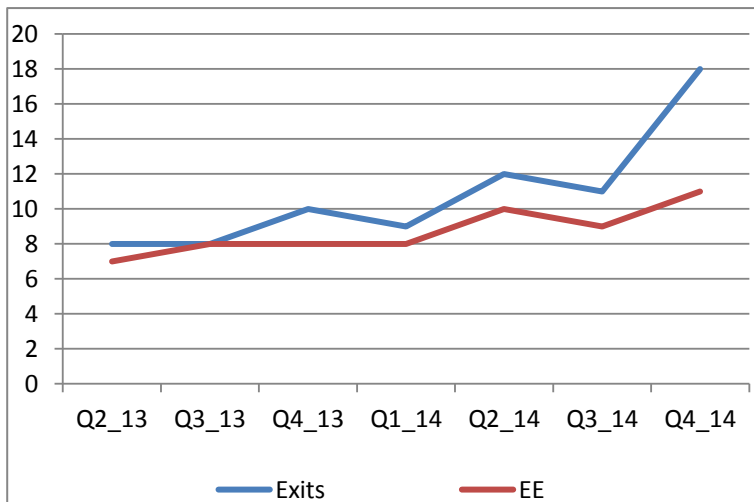

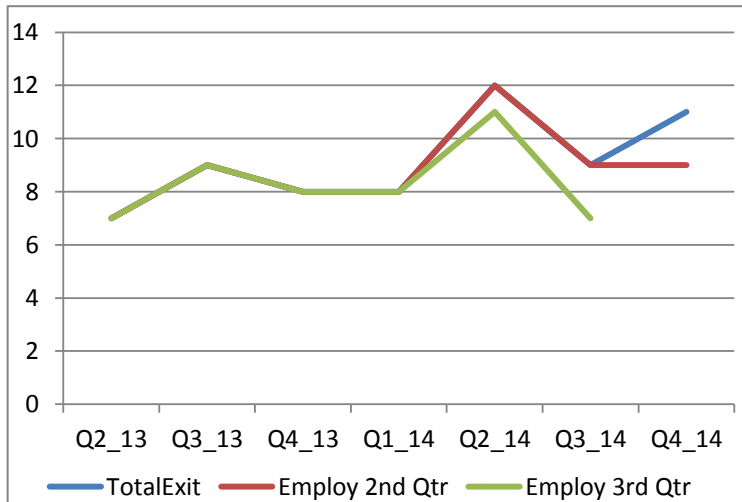


Indicators of Performance Outcomes for Trade Adjustment Assistance Act

Trade Act Entered Employment



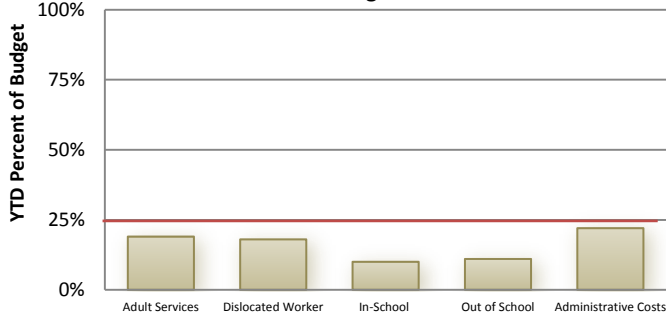
Trade Act Retention



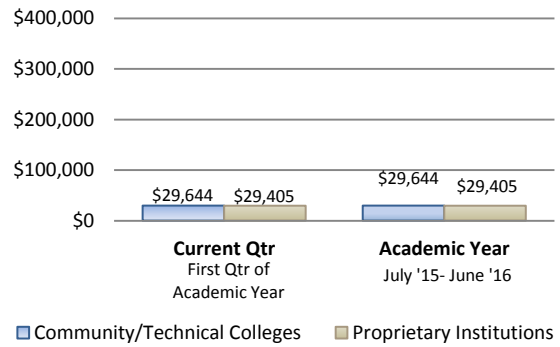

First Quarter of Program Year 2015

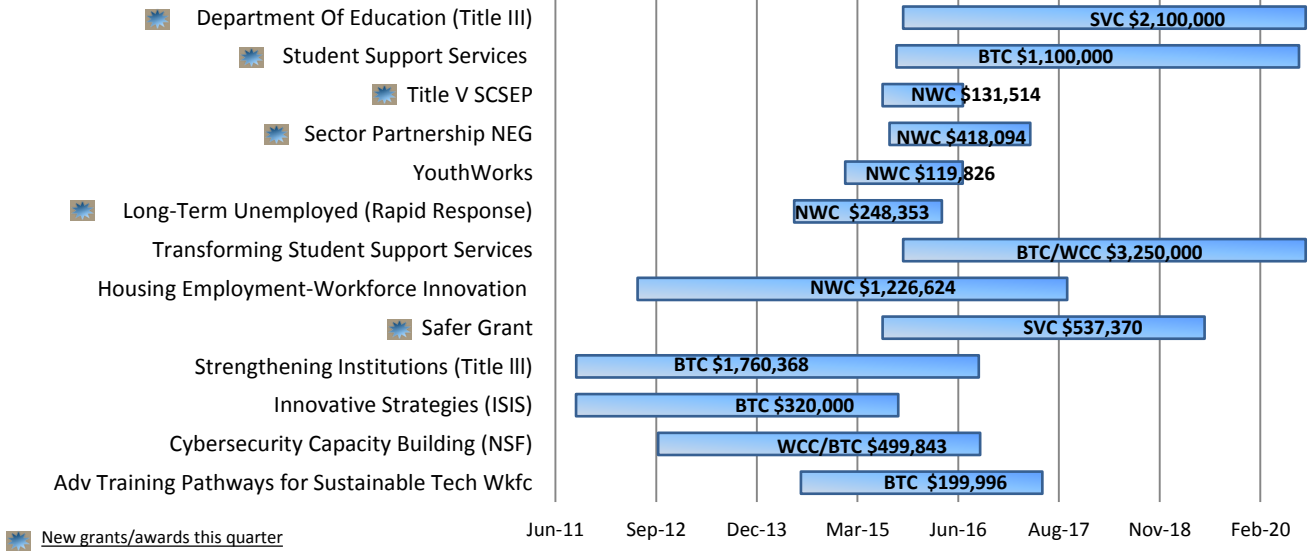

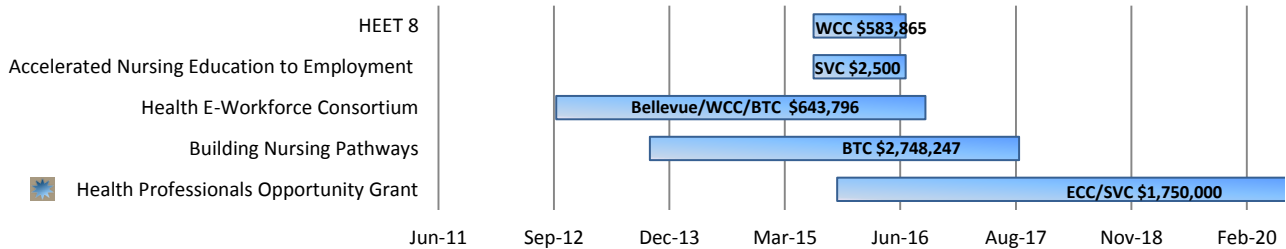

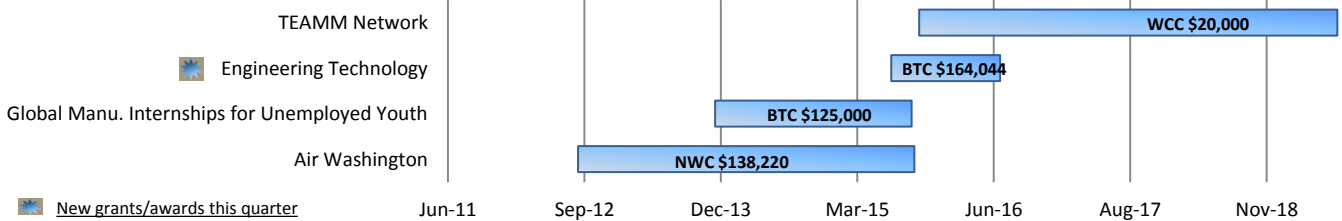

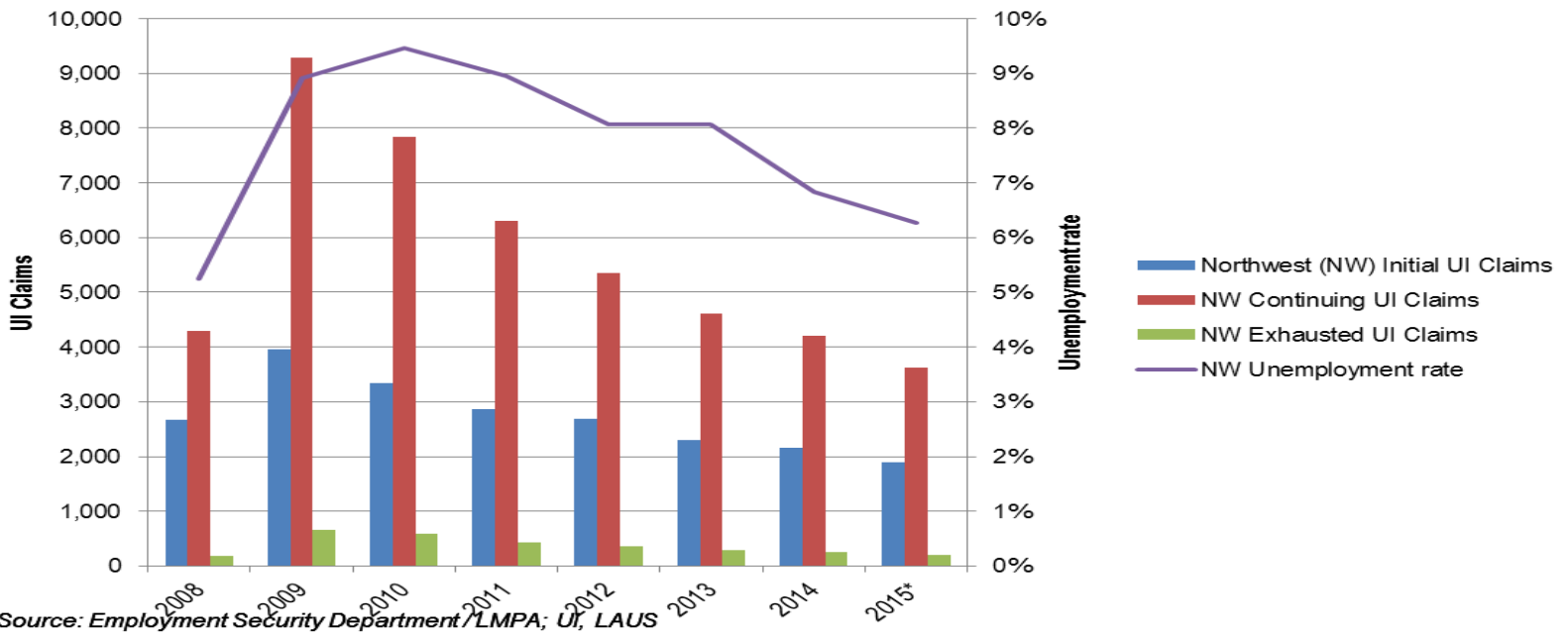

Northwest Average Monthly Unemployment Insurance (UI) Claims and Unemployment Rates, 2008 - 2015

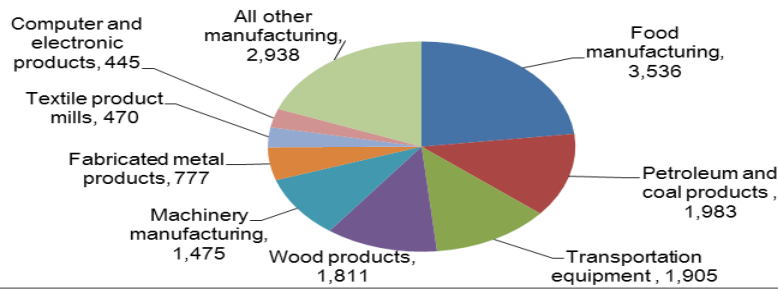


UI claims and labor force information (including unemployment rate) available through September 2015.

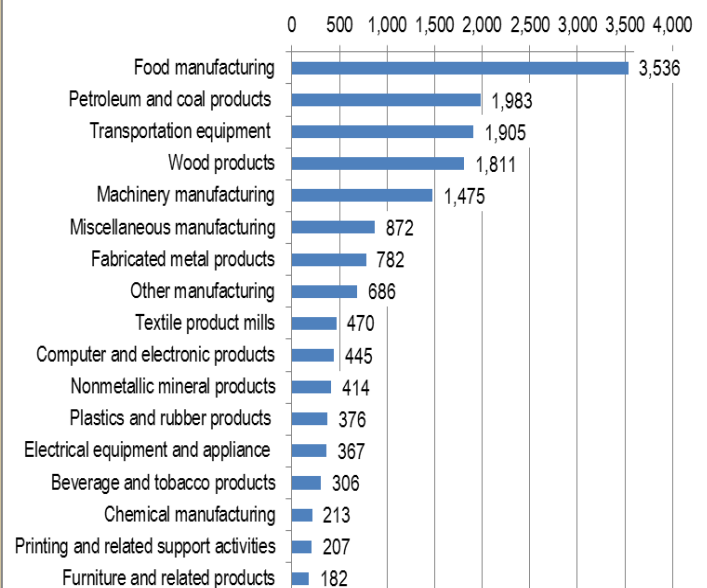
- ▶ Unemployment insurance claims declining each year since 2009.
- ▶ The number of Unemployment Insurance claims in January-September 2015 was lower than the number observed in 2014.
- ▶ After reaching a peak in 2010, the unemployment rate has been on a slow and steady descent.
- ▶ In the first three quarters of 2015, a total of 17,121 Northwest residents filed new UI claims and 1,769 exhausted regular UI benefits.
- ▶ In the first three quarters of 2014, the numbers were 18,470 and 2,328 respectively.
- ▶ The average number of continuing UI claims in the first three quarters of 2015 was 3,618, down from 4,348 in the first three quarters of 2014.
- ▶ In September 2015, the adjusted unemployment rate for Northwest Washington was 5.5%, compared to 6.4% in September 2014.
- ▶ In September 2015, Skagit County had the highest unemployment rate (6%), followed by Island County (5.5%), and
